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NOTES:

1. All Rates and Fees listed shall be increased by 75% of the Consumer Price Index (CIP), or 3%, whichever is lower, consecutively for four (4) years beginning May 1, 2023, through May 1, 2027, at which time the May 1, 2027, rates will become fixed until a new rate study justifies additional fees and charges.
2. 2025 CPI was 2.7%. Rate adjustment for May 1, 2025, is calculated ($2.7\% \times 75\% = 2.025\% < 3\%$). Use 2.025%.
3. Multi-family/munlti-housing enterprises on a single meter shall be billed a base charge for each unit, and all usage charges shall be billed at the Commercial Rate.
4. Mixed use single meter customers (customers that include a dwelling unit and a Business Permitted Enterprise) shall be billed at the Commercial Rates for water and sewer.
5. Water, but non-sewer customers (water-only) that do not discharge to the AWSD sewer system, will only be billed at the applicable Residential or Commercial rate(s).
6. Agricultural enterprise customers shall be billed at the Commercial Rate.
7. Desert Aire does not have or provide sewer (wastewater) service. Effective May 1, 2023, there is no flat rate.
